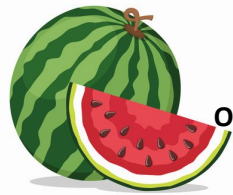


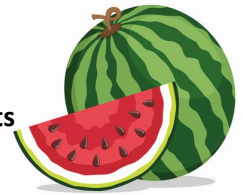

When should I complete a “Withdrawal From Treatment Allocation” CRF?

We are obviously keen for participants to adhere to their allocated treatment, but appreciate that a participant may wish to change treatment. If this occurs, **they do not need to withdraw from the Trial.**

Please only complete a Withdrawal Form (CRF #20) if the patient is withdrawing completely from the Trial.

Also, if a patient was given some cycles of chemotherapy, but stopped early, we do not need a Withdrawal from Treatment Allocation form. This information is collected on the End of Chemotherapy form.

Please give us a call if you are unsure!

If the participant was **allocated to receive Chemotherapy** but decided to **proceed with Endocrine Therapy only...**

Please send us:

CRF #21 - Withdrawal from Treatment Allocation

CRF #8 - End of Chemotherapy form confirming that “0” cycles of chemotherapy were given

CRF #10 - Hormone therapy form

If the participant was **allocated Endocrine Therapy only**, but decided to **proceed with Chemotherapy...Please send us:**

CRF #21 - Withdrawal from Treatment Allocation

CRF #7 - For all Chemotherapy cycles received

CRF #8 - End of Chemotherapy form

CRF #10 - Hormone therapy form

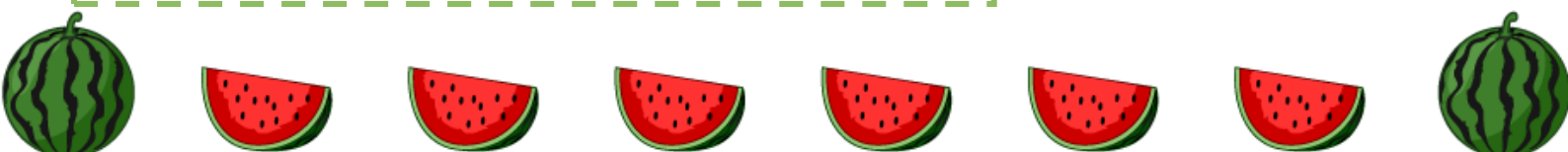

Abemaciclib

Abemaciclib use is allowed for all eligible OPTIMA patients. There is no requirement for chemotherapy use. The current protocol does not explicitly mention abemaciclib, but we are in the process of updating this. This will be the main change in Protocol version 9.
